


Budget Billing Make bill payments predictable

Budget Billing Program

- Helps offset the high winter heating and summer air conditioning peak bills
- Provides more predictable monthly energy costs to help you budget expenses
- Recommendation: Staying on Budget Billing for at least a year can help you avoid a seasonal peak bill



Enroll in Budget Billing today

- Free and easy to enroll
- You may start or end your participation in the program at any time
- This program is available to all residential customers, except those on a net energy metering rate plan, and small business customers on A1, A6, B1, B6 and GNR1 rate plans
- Participants must not be on a payment plan or have a history of partial or late payments

Learn how Budget Billing works

- Your most recent energy costs will be averaged over the last 12 months to determine your monthly payment amount
- Your monthly Budget Billing payment amount will be adjusted once every 4 months, if your actual energy usage has significantly changed
- While in the program, you may accrue an account balance or credit. If you unenroll from the program, this balance or credit will be reflected on your next energy statement
- To stay in the program, you'll need to pay the amount due on time each month
